Three FREE activities centered in Old Town Fairfax City on October 26

Fairfax, VA – Need plans this Saturday and not sure where to go? Fairfax City is the place to be on Saturday, October 26 as a number of community activities are scheduled throughout the day in Old Town Fairfax beginning at 10 am.

First, bring the little ones to Old Town Square, 10415 North Street, from 10 am to 1 pm for the **Witch Watch Halloween Festival**. Enjoy music, games, prizes, and much more at this spook-tacular *free* event. Halloween costumes are encouraged, and candy will be handed out in this safe trick-or-treating environment.

Then, from 1-7 pm, join us in your best costumes for the **Old Town Fairfax Fall Crawl**. The Fall Crawl is a timed self-guided event free to folks age 21+ featuring specials from nine Old Town Fairfax restaurants. Simply check in and pick up your passport at Red Effect, 3950 University Drive, #103. When you show the passport at the nine participating restaurants, you will receive access to exclusively priced food and drinks, and your passport will be stamped with every purchase. Collect four or more stamps for a free commemorative glass (while supplies last). Also, the first 24 passport-holders at participating restaurant will receive a Washington Nationals button. After the Fall Crawl, stop by Van Dyck Park and cheer on the Washington Nationals at the **Washington Nationals World Series Watch Party**, complete with food trucks and beer. The watch party is free with food and drinks available for purchase. Fans can begin rooting for the home team starting at 8-11:30 pm.
