

# NEIGHBORHOOD CONNECTED GRANT PROGRAM COMPONENTS

FAIRFAX CITY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT



The organization may propose a program to assist in economic development related work throughout Fairfax city; OR the organization can create a new external program in the frame of economic development and highlight/itemize anticipated financial needs. The proposed program must promote economic development and advance the mission of the non-profit.

## THE PROPOSAL MUST:

1. Support initiatives that stimulate economic growth and revitalization in the community; or
2. Promote job creation and workforce development programs that enhance employment opportunities for residents or students; or
3. Encourage entrepreneurship and small business development to foster a vibrant local economy; or
4. Marketing Fairfax City as a destination for business; or
5. Foster partnerships and collaboration among non-profit organizations, businesses, government entities, and community stakeholders.

To be considered for this grant the organization applying must submit a program proposal and spending plan. This proposal and plan should outline program timeline, implementation process, key staff and how monies will be spent. The organization will be required to submit an impact summary highlighting the benefits, experience, and fiscal impact the program was able to bring to the organization.
